Spanish Studies Course Sequencing

Students transferring into SPN from other programs need to take a placement test, available online through Canvas.

Borderline placement scores require resolution by oral interview, particularly if the student is attempting to get into a higher level course than the borderline score would indicate he/she is able to handle.

SPN classes generally follow their numerical designations.

SPN 3101 is obligatory for all students majoring or minoring in Spanish and must be taken before other upper division classes.

Spanish faculty recommend that students take SPN 3101 before SPN 3110.

After completion of SPN 3101 and 3110, students can take courses in upper division SPN without concern for sequence, reserving the Capstone (SPN 4899) for their senior year.
